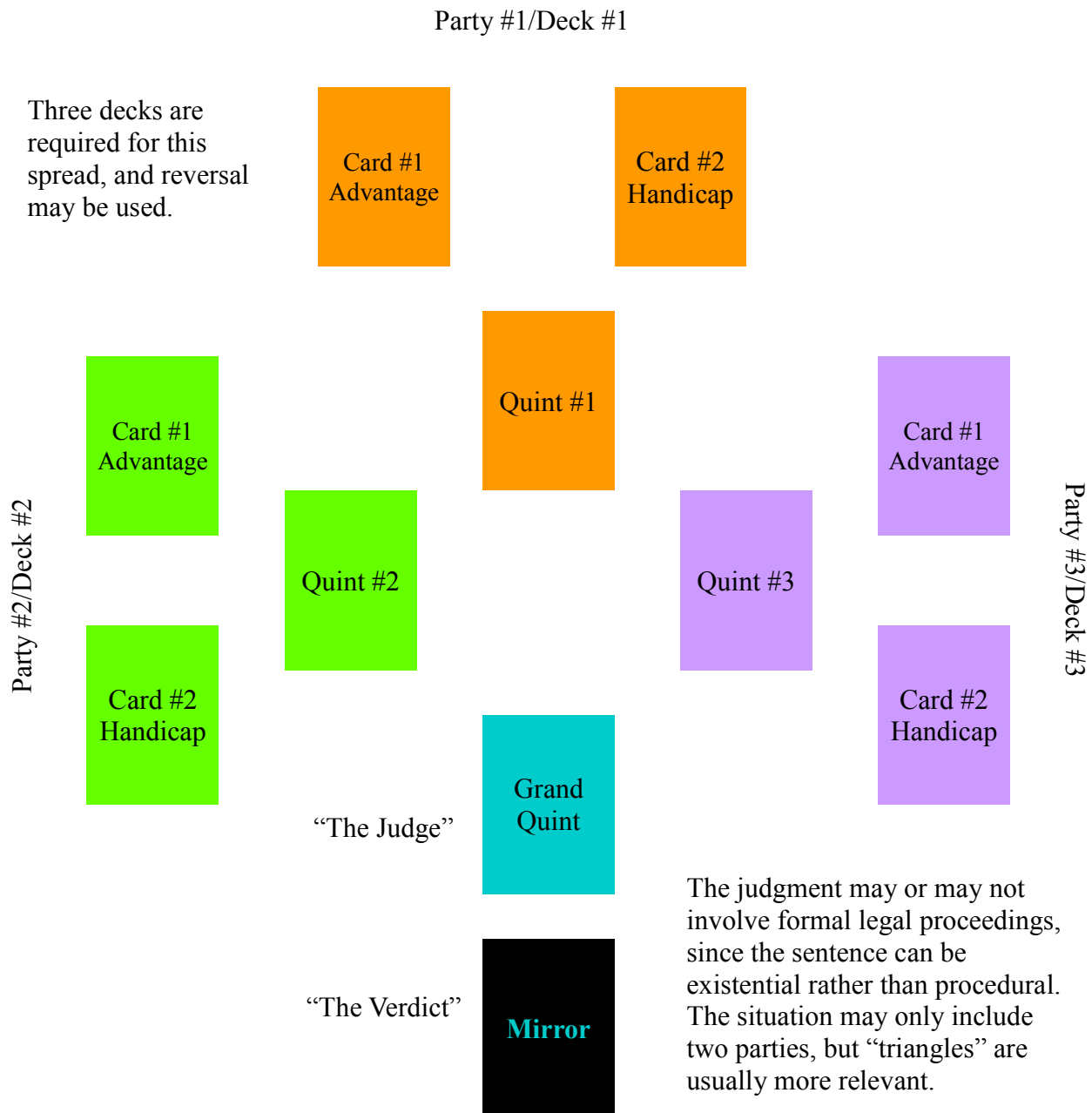


# The “3-Car Crack-up” Collision Course Spread

(A Multi-Party Confrontation Scenario)



The “Advantage” and “Handicap” cards, read as pairs, reveal which party is best positioned to survive the ordeal. The three sub-quints capture the blended quality of those combinations as trump cards. The Grand Quint is derived numerologically from the sub-quints, and shows by intrinsic nature and elemental dignity which of the three parties (sub-quints) has the sympathies of cosmic justice (the “Judge”) on its side. The “Verdict” is the trump card that mirrors the Grand Quint astrologically. Comparing the “Verdict” to the party that has the favor of the Judge will show whether the celestial jury agrees, and how likely that party is to be satisfied with the judgment. Poor alignment means an unfortunate outcome for that party, but not necessarily a favorable one for the other side.
